## "Brexit and what it means for Real Estate"



On the 24th November, Secretary of State for Transport and MP for Epson & Ewell Chris Grayling shall be joining members and guests of the 100 Property Club at their 61st Club Lunch, to discuss the importance and impact of Brexit on real estate in the UK, as well as other local matters. We are delighted that Chris can join us, and bring his wealth of experience, exposure and knowledge of UK Politics to the table.

Following the general election and the formation of the coalition government in May 2010, Chris was made Minister of State at the Department for Work and Pensions. Then in September 2012, after a UK Cabinet reshuffle, he was appointed Lord Chancellor and Secretary of State for Justice. Between 2015 – 2016 he was the Leader of the House of Commons and Lord President of the Council. And most recently in July 2016 he was appointed Secretary of State for Transport, a post he holds today.

Alongside this, Chris has been MP for Epsom and Ewell, his home constituency, since the 2001 General Election, and has been an active local MP involved in several important campaigns, including the battle to secure the future of Epsom Hospital. He is Patron of Nork Music in the Park and the locally-based charity the Forces Children's Trust, an Honorary Member of the Surrey Scout Council and Vice-President of the local Lest We Forget Association.
